The Roma Stories Oral History Project shares experiences and stories of Roma people from Eastern and Central Europe who live in London.

A series of orally transmitted histories focus on Roma persecution in the Second World War (Roma Holocaust), life in postwar communist countries and why and how individuals and families migrated to the UK. They tell us how Roma identity is perceived, how it is changing, how people have experienced living in London and how they 'belong' here.

The touring exhibition will include extracts from interviews, rarely seen archive photographs (Robert Dawson Collection, Roma Support Group) and artwork by Roma artist Robert Czibi.
