

Roma News Project - training opportunity



The Roma Support Group is working with On Road Media to deliver a media engagement programme for Roma activists. This involves a free, two half-days strategic communications training course, which will be designed and delivered by On Road and media activists from the Roma community.

What are we offering:

The participants will take part in a bespoke strategic communications media training course online over two half days. This will be facilitated by guest journalists and the experienced On Road Media team, and attended by staff from the Roma Support Group.

The training involves interview skills and learning around how the media works. The course covers what to expect on our project and how we, as a team, can be really strategic in how we communicate our experiences to the media – moving away from awareness raising to shifting people's thinking.

Following the training the project will offer monthly peer support sessions providing further opportunities to learn more media skills.
