

# Roma Support Group COVID-19 booster resource pack

We've created this resource pack for you to share with Roma communities that you work with, to give information on the COVID-19 booster and encourage greater vaccine uptake.

In early 2022 we met with members of Roma communities to identify the most effective way of communicating COVID-19 vaccine information. They shared that they were far more likely to trust and follow guidance from members of their own communities.

Accordingly, the resources we've created aim to address COVID-19 vaccine hesitancy among Roma communities by sharing the experiences of vaccinated Roma and giving information in community languages.
